

OBJECTIVE

- Objectives inform every aspect of the program
- Based on management goals & monitoring objectives

• Determine the required level of coverage & analysis, and therefore costs



STRUCTURE

- EM programs at RFMOs can fall into three categories
- RFMO-wide vs. Sub-regional vs. decentralized National Programs

 Affects contracting, cost sharing, standards, legislation



DATA STANDARDS

- Rules on how to how to collect, transmit, \bullet and store data
- Ensure uniformity across member nations
 Plan for adaptation and evolution \bullet and fleets
- Use performance standards when practical
